Motor Skills	<p>A. Sufficient motor function to execute movements required to perform general paralegal duties.</p> <p>B. Sufficient physical endurance to participate fully in the lab and academic settings at an appropriate level.</p>	<p>1. Example: Participate, with reasonable limits, to safely maneuver equipment and data to perform duties within scope of work.</p> <p>2. Example: Travel to trial locations, locations to search titles and use location skills to develop accident scenes.</p> <p>1. Example: Participate completely in classroom activities.</p> <p>2. Example: Participate fully in required activities in the clinical setting including extended periods of standing, lifting equipment, and walking briskly as is reflective of the general practice of a paralegal.</p>
Professional Conduct	<p>A. Understand and demonstrate ethical behavior.</p>	<p>1. Example: Evaluate ethical dilemmas in all areas of legal practice.</p> <p>2. Example: Find and interpret ethical rules for paralegals, attorneys, and judges.</p> <p>3. Example: Treat instructors and other students in a way that is both honest and fair.</p> <p>4. Example: Demonstrate integrity.</p>
Sensory	<p>A. Hearing sufficient</p> <p>B. Vision sufficient</p>	<p>1. Example: Hear clients and witnesses in interviews.</p> <p>1. Example: Has sufficient vision to read and research cases.</p> <p>2. Example: Has sufficient vision to handle evidence and view case scenes.</p>
